

Checklist – which documents are needed?

In the event of a death at home, please contact your GP (Hausarzt) or the out-of-hours medical service (116117). Following an examination, the doctor will certify the death and issue a death certificate. Once this is issued, we can arrange the transport of the deceased. We carry out the transport in our own vehicle and bring the deceased to our premises.

In the event of a death in a hospital, retirement home or care home, the doctor on call will be notified. Ring us any time to ask about steps before and after transport, as well as an appointment for a consultation: 06174 / 1345

Please bring the following documents with you to the consultation, if available:

- ☐ Birth certificate – for unmarried persons
- ☐ Family register or marriage certificate
- ☐ Divorce decree, if divorced
- ☐ Identity card (Personalausweis or Aufenthaltstitel etc.)
- ☐ Health insurance card
- ☐ Pension numbers
- ☐ Insurance policies
- ☐ Grave documents, if available
